## Uniform Policy

Concordia's student uniform is a Concordia branded shirt with tan, navy, or black bottoms (pants, shorts, skort, or skirt). Concordia tops are purchased at school. Bottoms are supplied by the family. All children wear a school uniform when attending school. As part of our respect for the school and its image, students should wear well-maintained uniforms. When an article of uniform clothing becomes worn or ill-fitting, the student/family should replace the article.
Especially as children grow, please make sure that all clothing is appropriately sized.
o No bare midriffs are allowed.
o Skirts and shorts may be no shorter than $\varsigma \mathrm{cm}$ above the knee, depending on an individual's height.

## UNIFORM TOP

All tops must be approved uniform wear and all visible undershirts must be plain white. To ensure uniform conformity if/when an outer top (for example: a uniform sweater, sweatshirt or long-sleeved top) is removed, another uniform shirt must be worn as a re-placement.

## UNIFORM BOTTOMS

Pants, shorts, skirts, or skorts are the styles of bottoms required for the school uniform in tan, navy blue, or black. Navy pants are available for purchase in Hanoi.

## ACCESSORIES

o Accessories should subtly complement the uniform. Large chains, scarves, etc., are not permitted.
o Socks and leggings must match the uniform. All styles, including knee socks and tights, if worn, must be a solid color of white or navy blue, without a pattern.



## SHOES

o Proper athletic shoes required for PE Classes and other sporting events. o For safety reasons, all shoes/sandals worn by Preschool - Grade s students must wrap behind the heel, or have a strap that wraps behind the heel. Because they do not have a strap behind the heel, rubber flip-flops, mules, slip-on sandals, and clogs are not allowed.
o Grade 6 \& above students may not wear rubber flip-flops, thongs, or slides. However, sandals without a strap behind the heel are fine.
o Rain boots are not allowed inside the classrooms. Children may wear rain
boots to school but should have an appropriate pair of shoes to change into for classroom wear.
o A flat or low heel shoe (not to exceed $\varsigma \mathrm{cm}$ in height) is considered acceptable uniform wear. High heels and stilettos are not permitted.

Students will be inspected for uniform policy conformity when they arrive at the school. A student who comes to school 'out of uniform' may be given a replacement to wear. The school may charge the family for the replacement. The infraction will be noted in the student's disciplinary record. If a student repeatedly violates the uniform policy, the parents will be involved in discussions for rectifying the situation.
